



## ***April 2008 Monthly Sales Revenue and Sales Volumes***

**May 14, 2008** - International Barrier Technology Inc. ("Barrier") (IBTGF: OTCBB; IBH: TSXV), a manufacturer of proprietary fire-resistant building materials has released revenue and sales volumes results for the month ending April 30, 2008. Overall revenue generated for the month was \$368,518 and shipments totalled 556,960 sq ft. Year to date sales revenue (July, 07-April, 08) is 3,897,382 and year to date shipments total 5,888,700 sq ft.

Of the \$368,518 in monthly sales revenue, \$165,350 was attributable to the Commercial Modular industry and \$21,910 to the Residential Roof Deck market. In the prior year, total monthly sales revenue was \$502,837. Year-to-date revenues are \$3,897,392, in comparison to \$5,200,480 in April 2007. Revenue generated from the Commercial Modular sector is up 20% year to year (\$1,606,784 vs. \$1,344,958). Revenue generated from the Multi-family Residential Roof Deck sector is down \$886,239, attributable to the depressed residential housing market. Structural Insulated Panel revenues are \$10,181 for the year.

Sales volume of shipments of Blazeguard product for the month ending April, 2008 was 556,960 sq ft. (Not included in this total was a rail car of Blazeguard (94,080 sq ft) scheduled to ship to Florida, but due to railroad delays, will instead ship in May.) This total compares to 783,008 sq ft that was shipped during April 2007, the highest shipment month in 2007. In April 2008, 479,584 sq ft shipped to Commercial Modular and 77,376 sq ft shipped into Multi-family Residential Roof Deck markets.

Year to date shipment volumes are 5,888,700 sq ft, in comparison to 7,369,500 sq ft through April 30, 2007. Shipments into the Commercial Modular market are up 16% from 4,115,300 sq ft to 4,792,200 sq ft. Multi-family Residential Roof Deck sales volumes are 1,029,900 sq ft vs. 3,225,400 sq ft last year. The majority of the decline (1,628,100 sq ft) is a result of the steep contraction in building in Florida. Since January, we have shipped 328,300 sq ft into Florida (122,500 sq ft more than what we shipped the entire calendar year of 2007) as building has slowly started to resume there. Year to date shipments into the Structural Insulated Panel market are 65,600 sq ft, an increase of 48,900 sq ft over last year.
