



February 2009 Monthly Sales Revenue and Sales Volumes

Sales Revenue Grows 5% Year-to-Date.

March 16, 2009 - International Barrier Technology Inc. ("Barrier") (IBTGF: OTCBB; IBH: TSXV), a manufacturer of proprietary fire-resistant building materials is releasing sales revenue and sales volume results year-to-date and for the month ending February 28, 2009. Year-to-date revenue has increased by 5% from \$3,112,182 to \$3,260,775. The Commercial Modular Market generated \$1,184,059; while revenue attributable to the Residential Roof Deck Market is \$482,102 and \$17,606 is from the sale of Structural Insulated Panels (this is in comparison to \$1,258,683, \$385,419, and \$10,181, respectively). Overall revenue generated for the month of February 2009 was \$196,007 vs. \$464,023 generated during the same month in 2008. Revenue into the Commercial Modular Market was \$82,960 (vs. \$182,920), while revenue into the Residential Roof Deck Market was \$19,194 in comparison to \$62,725.

Year-to-date sales volumes for the period July 08 - February 09 are 4,487,100 sq ft vs. 4,673,900 sq ft during the comparable period in the previous year. This includes 3,331,500 sq ft in Commercial Modular sales, 1,110,800 sq ft in Residential Roof Deck, and 44,800 sq ft in Structural Insulated Panels. Sales volume of shipments of Blazeguard product for the month ending February 28, 2009 was 291,200 sq ft. in comparison to 717,300 sq ft that was shipped during the same period one year ago. Shipments into the Commercial Modular Market were 244,000 sq ft vs. 554,300 sq ft in February 2008. Residential Roof Deck Market shipments were 47,200 sq ft (in comparison to 142,800 sq ft in February 2008). In 2008 there was 20,200 sq ft shipped into the Structural Insulated Panel Market.

While sales volumes were lower in the reporting period, overall we have remained consistent year over year, with slight growth in revenue. We have accomplished this while the economy continues to negatively impact the construction/building industry. We remain positive and focused on expanding market share along with developing new regions. Recently, we announced the addition of sales representation in both the Pacific Northwest and the Mountain states. We are looking forward to introducing Blazeguard® Fire Rated Sheathing into these regions as a solution for builders and home owners in these wildfire prone regions.
