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## Year-to-date and Monthly Sales Revenue and Sales Volumes for the period ending March, 31, 2010

**April 16, 2010** - International Barrier Technology Inc. ("Barrier") (IBTGF: OTCBB; IBH: TSXV), a manufacturer of proprietary fire-resistant building materials has released year-to-date fiscal (July 09 through March 10) and monthly revenue and sales volumes results for the period ending March 31, 2010. Overall revenue generated year-to-date is \$2,121,953 vs. \$3,474,374 during the same period in 2009. Revenue into the Residential Roof Deck/Wall Assembly Market was \$238,777 vs. \$533,117 in 2009. Revenue attributable to the Commercial Modular industry was \$905,966 (in comparison to \$1,239,743 year-to-date through March 31, 2009) and revenue from the Structural Insulated Panel market was \$6,502 vs. \$17,606. Revenue for the month of March 2010 grew 63% to \$349,089 from \$213,600 in March 2009. This included sales of commercial modular products that were purchased by Mule-Hide Products to build their inventory levels. Sales to them in future months may be impacted.

Sales volume of shipments of Barrier products for the year-to-date period July 2009 through March 2010 was 3,506,800 sq. ft. This is in comparison to 4,768,700 sq. ft. that was shipped during the same period last year. Residential Roof Deck/Wall Assembly sales were 659,700 (1,228,700 sq. ft. year-to-date through March 31, 2009). Commercial Modular shipments decreased year over year to 2,834,200 sq. ft. vs. 3,495,200 sq. ft. Shipments into the Structural Insulated Panel market for the nine months were 12,900 sq. ft. in comparison to 44,800 sq. ft.

Shipment volumes for the month ending March 31, 2010 were up 85% from 281,800 sq. ft. in March 2009 to 520,900 sq. ft. Shipments into Commercial Modular were 337,100 sq. ft., Residential Roof Deck/Wall Assembly Market shipments were 174,800 sq. ft. and Structural Insulated Panel volumes were 9,000 sq. ft. (vs. 163,800 sq. ft., 118,000 sq. ft., and 0 sq. ft. respectively in March 2009).

Since the end of February and throughout March, Barrier has begun to manufacture and ship the private label product, LP® FlameBlock™ Fire-Rated OSB Sheathing. Through LP's sales and marketing initiatives, new distribution sources have been identified and their focus on the California wildfire zones and wall assemblies in light commercial is generating strong market potential in addition to traditional residential roof deck business.
