



Manufacturer of Fire-Rated Building Materials, International Barrier Technology, Reports Revenue and Sales Volumes for November 2007.

Watkins, MN; Vancouver, BC December 19, 2007 - International Barrier Technology Inc. ("Barrier") (IBTGF: OTCBB; IBH: TSXV), a manufacturer of proprietary fire-resistant building materials has released revenue and sales volumes results for the month ending November 30, 2007. Total sales revenue generated from Blazeguard products was \$413,256, up slightly from October's revenue of \$403,556. The Commercial Modular sector contributed \$140,123 (vs. the \$81,860 generated last November) and the Residential Roof Deck sector contributed \$69,097 (vs. the \$201,698 generated in November 2006).

The total square footage shipped during the month was 584,256 sq. ft. in comparison to last year's total of 742,688 sq. ft. The Commercial Modular market continued on its growth path as sales volumes into that sector increased by 63% (from 259,872 sq. ft. in November 2006 to 423,744 sq. ft. in November 2007). The Residential Roof Deck market sales volumes remain at levels significantly lower than the same period last year (160,512 sq. ft. vs. 482,816 sq. ft.). The East Coast and the Midwest both showed increases, however; the South continues to be the main factor in the decline. For the first time since last March, Barrier did ship material into Florida. The 91,392 sq. ft. shipped was still overshadowed by the 391,136 sq. ft. shipped to Florida in November of 2006. However, it indicates to us that region may slowly be starting to build again.

"While we are disappointed by the continuation of the housing slump and its impact on Blazeguard sales, commercial business is providing sufficient sales volumes and revenues to keep our production lines working", reports Dr. Michael Huddy, Barrier's President and CEO. "We are seeing encouraging signs amidst the negative rhetoric portrayed in the media. Some areas remain extremely slow, but others are improving monthly with prospects for pockets of measurable recovery in 2008. Barrier is focusing on those areas that show the most potential for improvement in 2008 and expects sales volumes as compared to calendar year 2007 will improve significantly".
