



November 2008 Monthly Sales Revenue and Sales Volumes

December 15, 2008 - International Barrier Technology Inc. ("Barrier") (IBTGF: OTCBB; IBH: TSXV), a manufacturer of proprietary fire-resistant building materials has released revenue and sales volumes results for the month ending November 30, 2008. Overall revenue generated for the month was consistent at \$418,147 vs. \$421,641 generated during the same period in 2007. Revenue into the Commercial Modular Market grew 12% to \$158,305 from \$140,123 in 2007. Revenue attributable to the Multi-Family Residential Roof Deck market also grew slightly to \$63,868 (vs. \$59,776 in November 07). The price of panel substrate, a pass through for Barrier, is slightly lower this month in comparison to a year ago.

Sales volume of shipments of Blazeguard product for the month ending November 30, 2008 was 598,912 sq ft. This was a small increase over the 584,256 sq ft that was shipped during the same period one year ago. Commercial Modular Market shipments were up 6% from 423,700 sq ft to 449,792 sq ft. Multi-Family Residential Roof Deck shipments were 149,120 sq ft vs. 160,500 sq ft shipped during the same month last year. This included 140,200, sq ft into Florida, as the market in that region has cautiously continued construction on new projects.

Included in the Commercial Modular shipments was a car load of FR Deck Panel products that were shipped to a new distributor in Edmonton, Alberta Canada. We are well positioned to service current business in Alaska and excited about prospects for further growth throughout Canada.
